Purpose:

The Facility Caretaker plays a key role in executing targeted facility projects that enhance safety, function, and member experience at LaunchSpace. While the primary focus is on project-based tasks—such as light repairs, equipment improvements, and workspace upgrades—there is also opportunity to support general space organization as time allows.

Primary Responsibilities: Special Projects (Core Focus)

- Complete small-scale facility improvement projects as assigned (e.g., building tool storage, fixing workbenches, improving ventilation, labeling systems).
- Perform light maintenance tasks to ensure tools and mechanical systems remain safe and functional.
- Work with the senior staff to identify priorities and plan out small upgrades or seasonal improvements.
- Support preparations for events and programs by assisting with workspace readiness, equipment relocation, or minor repairs.

Secondary Responsibilities: Organization & Support (As Time Allows)

- Reset studios or shared spaces after peak use or programs.
- Help maintain order in tool storage, supply closets, and shared resource areas.
- Identify and report facility needs or safety concerns to senior staff.

- Experience using tools, building or repairing, and working independently
